I'm very new to animation and more of a scripter, but I thought it would be a good idea to give one the better known 2D animation packages a spin and tell you lot what I thought of it as a beginner animator.

When opening toon boom the first thing that hits you is the nice layout, now me being a flash addict, like all things macromedia, so it was nice to see that this interface looked similar to that of Flash.

You have your tools on the left on a floating bar, 6 drawing tools with a pen (stroke) adjustment, 7 colour fill options, eraser and cut options and lastly selection options. With all of these tools and the Flash import option I was ready to make my first Animation, I decided that because my drawing sucked and I haven't got a tablet, that I would stick to something simple, I produced a bouncing ball J, I know I have a really cool bit of kit and I produce a ball. Moving on...

Like flash toon boom has layers or 'Exposure sheet' as toon boom call it,

Each exposure sheet acts like a different frame in your animation, so as you can guess making a bouncing ball took all of 2 minutes.

Just copy and paste into the next exposure sheet then make the movement's, it's as easy as that.

The exposure sheet has a few more options to add a sound and media options so you can add a background music to your
